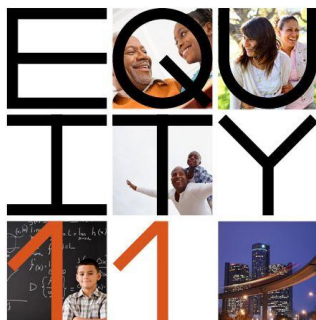
Despite cultural and other differences between societies, all communities face very similar challenges and opportunities, even if their solutions and approaches to managing change may differ.
