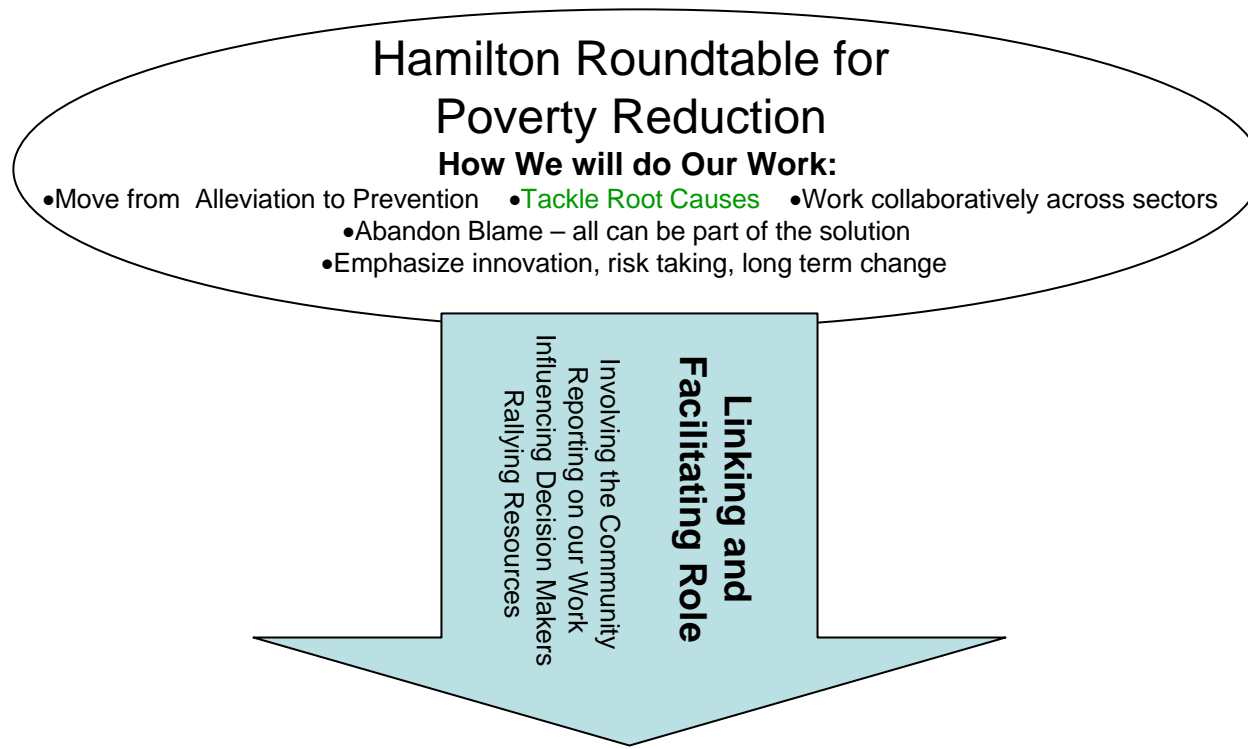
Critical Points of Investment in Children and Youth in Hamilton
