

New Brunswickers Invited to Help Reduce Poverty

The government of New Brunswick has committed to establishing a provincial poverty reduction plan. This initiative, to be completed by the end of 2009, will be conducted in three stages: a dialogue phase; a round table phase; and a final forum phase. The result will be the publication of a poverty reduction plan for New Brunswick.

Public meetings will take place in the regions of Bathurst, Campbellton, Caraquet, Edmundston, Fredericton, Miramichi, Moncton, and Saint John. The process will start in January 2009 and conclude in the fall of 2009 with the final forum.
