

**Russell Mawby** is the Director of Housing for the City of Ottawa, as well as the Director responsible for the City's new Neighbourhood Planning Initiative. He received his Bachelor of Architecture from the University of Waterloo in 1993, and worked for a large design firm before concentrating on the housing field. He founded the Collaborative Housing Society in 1991 to promote and support the concept of cohousing in Canada, and in 1996, worked for the City of Saskatoon developing municipal and community capacity, policies and programs for housing and neighbourhood development. He has spoken nationally and internationally on issues related to the role of housing in building sustainable, healthy communities. He has served on a number of Boards, including the Canadian Housing and Renewal Association, and is currently a member of the Association of Municipalities of Ontario Task Force on Housing and Homelessness.
