

CSR in BC's Capital Region

May 13-19 marked the first annual Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Week in BC's Capital Region. Local partners including the Quality of Life CHALLENGE came together to build awareness and understanding of the broader role of business in the community and showcase local examples of CSR practices that are reducing poverty amongst the waged poor and enhancing quality of life.



The partners hosted a "Progressive Supper Theatre" on Monday, May 15. Nearly 100 people came together to participate in an innovative evening to launch the new Vancouver Island Social Purchasing Portal and the Quality of Life CHALLENGE *Living Wage dialogue* on the real costs of living in BC's Capital Region. The Living Wage dialogue focuses on the real costs of living in the region, the challenges to employers, and the range of Human Resources options employers can consider to move employees towards a living wage.
